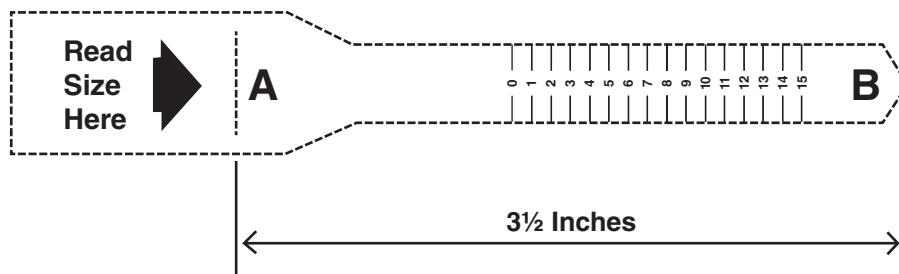


Spare Rings are available in sizes 7-15. Print this guide to help you find the correct size for you!

METHOD 1

IF YOU DON'T CURRENTLY HAVE A RING - MEASURE YOUR FINGER

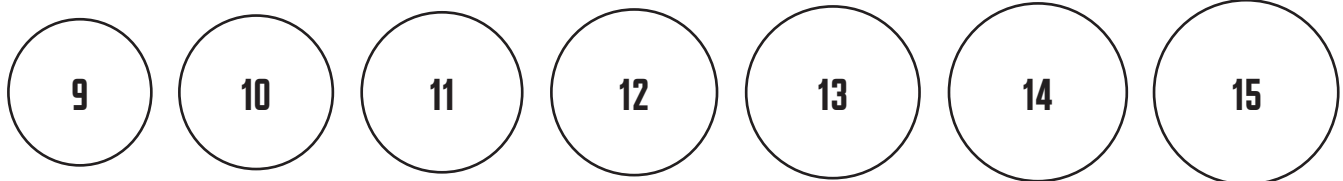
1. Cut out the ring sizer below.
2. Cut a slit on the dotted "A" line.
3. Wrap the sizer around your finger. Make sure the numbers are facing out.
4. Pull the pointed "B" tab through slot "A" until the sizer is snug (make sure to allow space for your knuckle if it sizes larger).
5. The number that aligns with the "A" slot is your ring size. *If you fall between two numbers, choose the smaller size of the two.



METHOD 2

IF YOU ALREADY HAVE A RING BUT DON'T KNOW THE SIZE - MEASURE THE RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place ring on top of the circles below until the inside edge of the ring matches the outside edge of one of the circles.



PRINTING INSTRUCTIONS

Make sure your printer is set to 100%. Do not reduce the print size "to fit" in the page setup area. Once printed, verify the sizer by measuring with a ruler - it should measure 3.5" from the "A" slot to the "B" point.
